## **Big welcome for Bishop Martin in Kagera**

The Bishops' Lent Appeal has enabled our Diocese to help finance projects such as: the building of dormitory accommodation at Ngara Anglican Primary School, the Church and Community Mobilisation Process - a project to encourage self-sufficiency, with training in new farming methods and provision of new seed varieties,

the Kagera Theological Training College - provision of training for lay leaders and a diploma course leading to ordination, helping pastors with their expenses and to give parishes funds to improve their local communities.

Bishop Martin has been able to see these projects in action, and he commented: "We are supporting projects in schools and agriculture enabling people to be self-sustaining. The relationship with Kagera is a mutual benefit as there is a huge amount that we can gain and learn from the relationships we have with the people here in Kagera".
