

Welcomers:

This would include welcoming the congregation to our services and handing out hymn books and Orders of Service.

Readers:

This involves reading the lessons during the service.

Serving Communion:

Assisting with Communion would involve assisting the Priest in preparation of the table/elements and serving the consecrated blood of Christ in the wine.

Crucifer (Holy Innocents):

The Crucifer is a person who is appointed to carry the Church's processional cross, or crucifix, during processions at the beginning and end of the service.

Candlebearers (Holy Innocents):

This role is left open for young people who would like to be on placement with us for their Duke of Edinburgh awards or other community engagement, with the hope that this will become a regular server role.
