

BENEFICE CORONAVIRUS UPDATE 20 MARCH 2020

As you are aware due to the Coronavirus situation the Benefice of Holy Innocents, Gt Barton and St Peter's Thurston have followed advice from the Diocese and suspended all services and activities. Also following advice today, we are unable to deliver home communions, communion by extension or other forms of communion in homes.

Visiting the elderly and the vulnerable in the usual format is suspended. If visiting in person, it is recommended that the visitor stays outside, and an appropriate distance is kept. While we must look after those who are self-isolating and those who live alone, support by telephone or email is a much safer option of staying in touch.
